



**Professor Ioannis E. Messinis, MD, PhD (UK), FRCOG**

**Professor Ioannis E. Messinis** is Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of Thessaly, Larissa, Greece (since 1995, currently Emeritus). He has two MD degrees (theses) in Greece (University of Athens and University of Ioannina) and a PhD (Doctor of Philosophy) in the UK (University of Aberdeen). He is Honorary Fellow “ad eundem” of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG - UK). In the past, he worked in Uppsala, Sweden as Research Fellow (1 year) and in the UK in Edinburgh (1 year) and in Aberdeen at the position of Senior Lecturer (4 years). His research interest is in Reproductive Endocrinology and he has more than 230 published articles in international peer review journals. He has received several research grants and honours. Also, he has given more than 300 lectures in International Meetings as an invited speaker. He is a member of the Editorial Board of several international journals and a regular reviewer. He is Past Dean of the School of Health Sciences, University of Thessaly and Past Rector of the University of Thessaly. He has been also a member of the Advisory and the Executive Committees of various International Organizations (ESHRE, EBCOG, MSRM). He is Immediate Past President of the Mediterranean Society for Reproductive Medicine (MSRM). Currently, he is a Member of the Executive Committee of EBCOG, Director of Examinations and Chair of the Standing Committee on Examinations of EBCOG. He is also Section Editor of the international journal, Reproductive Biomedicine Online (RBMO).
