



Keckstein Jörg graduated from 1970 to 1976, studying medicine at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University Munich . He was an assistant physician at the Women's Hospital of the University of Ulm (1976/1977), the Municipal Gynecological Clinic Heilbronn (1978/1979), and from 1979 to 1984 at the University Women's Hospital in Ulm . After completion of the specialist retraining 1984 he worked from 1985 to 1993 as a senior physician , later acting senior physician, continue to operate there. In 1990 Keckstein habilitated at the University of Ulm.

In 1993 Jörg Keckstein moved to the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology of the Department of Minimally Invasive Surgery. Krüsmann in Munich . In 1996 he was appointed associate professor of the University of Ulm. In the same year he moved as a Primarius of the Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics to the Regional Hospital Villach in Carinthia . Here he is in charge of the first stage III endometriosis center of the European Endometriosis League. In October 2011, Keckstein was honored with the Golden Scope of the Association Gynecological Endoscopy of the German Society of Gynecology and Obstetrics . [1]
