Panagiotis Drakopoulos was born on August 8, 1984 in Athens (Greece). He graduated with an excellent grade from the Faculty of Medicine (University of Athens). He completed his residency in Gynecology and Obstetrics in the University Hospital of Geneva, Switzerland. He earned a Master degree (MSc) in reproductive medicine and a university diploma of statistics for clinical research from the University of Geneva. He performed his subspecialty training in reproductive medicine in the Center for reproductive medicine (CRG), UZ Brussel, Belgium. He is recognized as a subspecialist in reproductive medicine and surgery by ESHRE and EBCOG.

Dr Drakopoulos has authored more than 33 peer-reviewed publications. He serves as reviewer in several high indexed journals of his field, including Human reproduction update, Human reproduction, Fertility and Sterility, Reproductive biomedicine online, Journal of Assisted Reproduction and Genetics and Gynecological endocrinology. His research is mainly focused on the endocrinology of reproduction and on strategies to improve the outcome of low prognosis patients.
